Established in 1994 and supported by the U.S. Department of Energy (DOE), the National Renewable Energy Laboratory (NREL), the National Association of Home Builders (NAHB), and numerous private sponsors, the EVHA honors builders who elevate the standards for high-performance home building by voluntarily incorporating energy efficiency into all aspects of new home construction. Winners are selected from among applicant builders who compete from three climate regions (cold, moderate, hot) in five categories (affordable, custom, factory-built, production, and multifamily).

EVHA Winners are announced and honored at the EVHA Banquet held during the International Builders' Show. Each receives a plaque, marketing resources to be used for publicity in their local market, copies of the EVHA Winners publication, recognition on the NAHB Research Center website, and national recognition through news releases, websites, and a live link from the Research Center's website to each winner's website.
